- **Child Nutrition Services**
 - \$80 Million
 - Appropriation would include Child Nutrition Program operating costs and supplemental employee compensation for the final 8 weeks of the 2019-2020 Academic Year
- **Whole Child Support**
 - Increased Social/Emotional Support Staff
 - \$50 Million (Reoccurring)
 - Appropriation would include support for School Social Workers, School Psychologists, School Nurses, and School Counselors for low-performing schools
- **High Quality K-12 Instructional Resources**
 - “Summer Bridge- Jump Start Program”
 - \$75 Million
 - K-3 Literacy and Core Instructional Support for COVID-19 Response
 - \$1.5 Million
 - Digital Teaching and Learning Resources and Professional Learning Opportunities

- \$50 million
 - Internet Connectivity
 - Devices for Students- Chromebooks
 - Devices for Staff- Chromebooks
 - Digital Curricula
 - Digital Curricula Development
